Sportsmanship and Dart Etiquette

A few things have happened that make it necessary to bring up the subjects of sportsmanship and dart etiquette. Verbal abuse, cursing tirades and bad behavior are not welcomed at WADA matches. If someone is bothering you or being a general nuisance to the game, please alert your captain, who should then address it with the opposing team's captain. If the captain is the problem and it can't be handled onsite please contact me or one of your regional directors (shown at the lower left of this page). Arguments are a two way street so try to remove yourself from the argument before it gets out of hand.

Also, some matches are not being completed within a reasonable expectation. We've all been it that game that involves 50 darts at the double or the bull, and the first thing we might have to do right after that game is run to the restroom. That's understandable. But if every break is a long one, lineup exchanges take fifteen minutes or smoke breaks turn social hour, it's time to reconsider your behavior. Lineups should be exchanged and play should begin in a reasonable time. If you have a board available, consider exchanging lineups and starting the next round. C League matches should not take more than four hours.

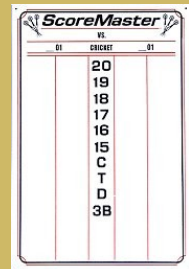
"A" League: 9Mk, T70, T40 in/out, 6 bulls

"B" League: 7Mk, T33, T20 in/out, 4 bulls

Games People Play: Minnesota Cricket

Have you ever seen a scoreboard that extended past 20-15-Bull to include T-D -B at the bottom and wondered what they were for? They stand for Triples, Doubles and Beds. There are a number of cricket, half-it, and rotation games that utilize these targets. The most popular names used for this variation are Minnesota Cricket, Moose, Milwaukee, Mouse or Wild Mouse, depending on where you play the game.



These cricket variations includes having to hit three doubles, three triples, and three 3-in-a-bed shots (all three darts in the same number). You can score on the triples, doubles and beds the same as the cricket numbers. One dart cannot count two different ways. If you hit a triple 20 in your first turn, you can count it as three 20s or as one triple, not both. All versions are played "slop" so you don't have to call your shot. In Minnesota, Moose (and Mouse) you can only hit cricket numbers for your doubles, triples, and beds. In Milwaukee (or Wild Mouse) you can hit non-cricket numbers so that irritating triple one you inevitably hit aiming at the triple twenty will finally count for something).
