The 2013 WADA and Women-of-WADA Series of Darts Official Rules & Regulations

1. WADA Series of Darts Eligibility

In order to participate in any WADA Series of Darts or Women of WADA Series of Darts event you must be a WADA member in good standing. If you are not a current member of WADA, you may join WADA at any WSOD or WOW event. WOW does not require a separate membership.

2. Glossary of Terms (in order of usage)

WADA – Washington Area Darts Association WSOD – WADA Series of Darts WOW – Women of WADA Series of Darts QE – Qualifying Event CMM – Captain's Meeting Madness Event LCQ – Last Chance Qualifying Event

3. WSOD Qualifier Events

A \$5 fee per entry per event will be required by each participant in a WSOD QE. Entry fees will be matched by the host establishment. Players who have already qualified for the main event may not participate at a subsequent WSOD QE. Women may continue to play in a WSOD QE if they have qualified for WOW Finals. There will be eight (8) qualifier events.

The format for all qualifier events (QE) is a knockout, doubleelimination bracket. The First Qualifier Bracket (a.k.a. "winners" bracket) format will be a best of five legs of 501 except in the final match which will be a best of seven legs. One toss of a coin will determine who throws first in odd legs and should the game be tied, then the players shall throw for the bull to decide who will throw first in the deciding leg.

The Second Qualifier Bracket (a.k.a. "losers" bracket) format will be a best of three legs of 501 except in the final match which will be a best of five legs. One toss of a coin will determine who throws first in odd legs and should the game be tied, then the players shall throw for the bull to decide who will throw first in the deciding leg. The two qualifiers from each qualifier event will be seeded into the Main Event.

4. WOW Qualifier Events

The WOW QE will be play in bracket format as the third bracket of the WSOD QE. Position in the WOW bracket is determined by final position in the corresponding WSOD QE, meaning each woman is given a bye surviving additional rounds of the next participant. Any non-WOW qualified WSOD qualifier has an automatic bye into the WOW QE finals, unless both WSOD QE qualifiers are participating in which case the "winners" bracket winner will be seeded into the finals and the "losers" bracket winner will be seeded into the semi-finals. If two women are eliminated in the same round, the tie breakers will be the amount of wins in the eliminating round, followed by order of elimination from the WSOD event (a.k.a. last women standing).

All rounds of the WOW QE bracket will be single elimination 501 except in the final match which will be a best of three legs. One toss of a coin will determine who throws first in odd legs and should the game be tied, then the players shall throw for the bull to decide who will throw first in the deciding leg.

5. WSOD and WOW Captain's Meeting Madness Event

A \$5 entry fee per event will be required by each participant in the WADA Series of Darts Captain's Meeting Madness event. There will be four captain's meeting madness event's, which will take place at the conclusion of each region's captain's meeting. A player may compete in any and all captain's meeting madness event regardless of where they play unless they have already qualified for the WSOD Main Event and WOW Finals.

The Captain's Meeting Madness event format involves two stages. Stage One: Competition is based on the total score achieved in nine darts. Stage Two: At the conclusion of Stage One, the top 6 players, as determined in Stage One play, plus all ties and at least two WOW participants, will play a single leg of 701. The first two players to double out will qualify for the main event. The first woman to double out will qualify for the WOW Finals. Women who are already WOW qualified need to be tied or better than the top 6 in order to compete for the WSOD.

6. WSOD Main Event and WOW Finals Registration

All qualified players must register for the WADA Series of Darts 30 minutes prior to the start of the main event to verify that they are participating in the main event. Any of the previously qualified players who do not register will be summarily disqualified from the WADA Series of Darts event and a replacement player will be qualified through a special Captain's Meeting Madness event. All disqualified players will forfeit any prize money or expected compensation.

7. WSOD and WOW Last Chance Qualifier Event

In the event that a qualified contestant fails to register for the WSOD Main Event of the WOW Finals, an additional event will be held to qualify a replacement player. An entry fee of \$10 or half of the lowest payout (whichever is higher) will be required by each participant in the Last Chance Qualifier events. This competition is open to any player who has taken part in any prior 2013 WSOD or WOW event. The WADA Series of Darts Last Chance Qualifier event involves two stages. Stage One: Competition is based on the total score achieved in nine darts. Stage Two: At the conclusion of Stage One, the top two players per open slot, as determined in Stage One play, plus all ties, will play a single leg of 701. For example, if one slot is open then two will make stage two, for two open slots four make stage two, etc.) The first players to double out will qualify for the main event and will be seeded into the Main Event based on open slots. WOW will have an independent LCQ using the same format.

8. WSOD Main Event and WOW Finals Seeding

The 16 qualifiers from the WSOD brackets will be seeded based on order of qualification in the Qualifying Events, however the winner of each qualifying event will have a bye into the round of 16 (WOW into the quarter finals).

9. WADA Series of Darts Main Event Play

The Main Event is a single elimination seeded knock out bracket. The First and Second rounds of the main event are best of seven (race to four). Quarter Final and Semi Final is best of 9 (race to 5), and the Final Event is best of 11 (race to 6).

10. WSOD Main Event and WOW Finals Payout

100% of the funds received for male participants go toward the WSOD Main Event. 100% of the funds from female participants go toward the WOW Finals. Prize money will be awarded as follows: Main Event Champion will receive 30%, Runner-up 15%, Top 4 7.5%, Top 8 4%, positions 9-16 2%, 17-24 1%. This is a 100% payback event. Prize money for the WOW finals will be awarded as follows: The WOW Event Champion will receive 32%, Runner-up 16%, Top 4 10%, Top 8 5%, positions 9-12 3%. This is a 100% payback event. Prize money for the WSOD Main Event will be made up of men's entry fees and sponsor matches to WSOD events, and any additional sponsor moneys received for the WSOD Main Event. Prize money for the WOW Finals will be made up of ladies WSOD entry fees, and any additional sponsor moneys received for the WOW Finals.
