Winmau Rolling Singles Qualifiers

We are holding "rolling" singles qualifiers for Winmau Masters Regional. The Regional will be held April 1 at Mighty Mikes. Details about the qualifiers are attached at the end of this Weekly. There are 5 remaining qualifiers. At each qualifier, you will play 21 legs of 501—you receive 1 point per leg won, plus 5 points just for showing up. If there are at least 8 players at the event, the overall winner will receive a Golden Ticket straight to the Regional. After the final Qualifier, remaining funds will be used to send as many people as possible to the Regional based on points earned over the course of the qualifiers. You don't have to play every week to win—show up when you can. The next event is Sunday, March 5 at noon at Mighty Mikes (note that this is a change from the original schedule). Hope to see you there!

Seeking All Stars to Challenge Pittsburgh

WADA has accepted a challenge from the Pittsburgh darters club. An All Star Team representing WADA will travel to the Steel City Open on August 20-21, 2017, to compete against a team of All Stars representing the Pittsburgh club. In 2018, the Pittsburgh team will come to the Washington Area Open to compete on our turf. Each team tentatively would consist of 12 men and 6 women shooters. The exact format of the challenge will be released at a later date. All Star qualifications/selections likely will be made at the Spring Annual Meeting. Details are still being worked out, but we are open to suggestions for selection competitions/criteria. WADA won't be able to fund travel to Pittsburgh, but we would be happy to help hold fundraising lucks or aid in other ways. If you might be interested, keep it on your mind and start planning now!

Games People Play: 51 in Fives

This is fun game that may be played by any number of players. The object is to be the first player to reach a score of exactly 51. Diddle for the middle to determine the playing order. A running total is kept vertically below each player's name to show the current score he or she has.

Each player throws three darts trying to score a total of the three darts that is EXACTLY divisible by 5. If the player's total is not divisible by 5, all three darts do not count (like a bust). If the player's total is exactly divisible by 5, divide the total by 5 and that number is the score for the round. For example, a player throws a single 20, a single 20 and a single 5. The score for that player would be 9 (20+20+5=45 45/5=9). If any dart misses the board entirely, all three darts thrown in that round do not count.

To win the game, a total of 51 must be hit exactly. If the total ends up more than 51, all three of the darts thrown in that round do not count and the score remains the same.

Tips? Find the 5-wedges. The two best places on the board to throw are at the 20/5 area or the 10/15 area. Each of these areas give a nice wide target where hitting either number leaves you divisible by 5. Of course, you could also throw single and double bulls!

Player Requirements:

- Players must register at their first event.
- Players will pay a fee of \$40 before their first game is played.
- The fee covers entry into every event listed above for the current season.
- New registrations will be taken up to sixth event. You don't have to play in every event come when you can!
- Non-members must join WADA to participate (\$10 lifetime membership fee).

Sponsor bar agreement:

- The sponsor will reserve 8 boards for league play from Noon-6PM.
- The sponsor will donate a "bar match" per player per event.

Format:

- All games are 501.
- Seven (7) sets of three (3) for a total of 21 games.
- Round-robin bracket will be set and names will be drawn into positions randomly.
- A second random draw will determine which rounds will be played.
- If there are fewer than 8 players at any event, the second random draw will determine which rounds will be played again to allow for 21 games.

Standings and Prizes:

- Anyone who wins an event with at least 8 shooters will be automatically awarded a golden ticket for their first win. For women, a bracket with at least six women shooters will count.
- Women's proceeds will go toward the Women Qualifiers (including bar match).
- Final point standings determine which players receive the remaining golden tickets.
- One player for every \$110 collected will be awarded a "golden ticket" as their prize.
- Every player is awarded five points for each week played and one point per win.
- Ties are broken by a three game playoff.
- A maximum of one golden ticket may be won each season per shooter.
- The golden ticket may either be a virtual or actual item, depending on cost and will include a paid entry into the regional qualifier for the Winmau Masters.
- If you qualify for the Winmau Masters through another tournament you may use your golden ticket for any of the other three ADO regional qualifiers.
- Remaining funds will go toward the last golden ticket and the remaining balance will be split between the qualifier and WADA or will "carryover" to the next season.
- The last ticket holder can pay their share via cash or paypal to WADA.
- WADA will send a list of players and a check for fees into the ADO regional.
